In the Efficacy pillar:

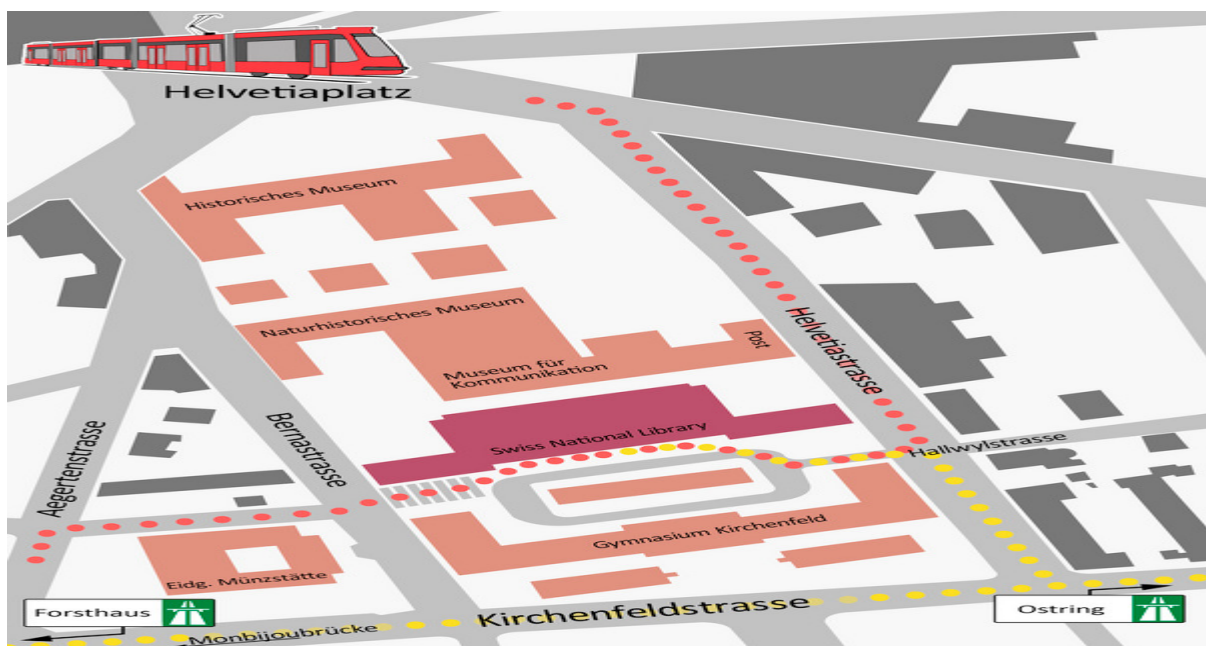
- Assessment inflammatory disease
