By train: Leave Bern train station via the “Welle” pedestrian overpass above Platforms 1–13. As soon as you have negotiated the two flights of stairs, turn left and follow the tram tracks along Stadtbachstrasse. After about 300m Wildhainweg branches off to the right. The reception is at Wildhainweg 3. Walking time: 5 minutes.

By car: Leave the A1 Zurich–Lausanne–Geneva motorway at the Bern Forsthaus exit and continue on straight until you reach the Insel Spital parking, on your left. Immediately after, turn left, cross the bridge, and turn right. Wildhainweg is about 300m further to your left up a steep street. A very limited number of parking places is available.
