## Cancer Mission

### 1. Destinations, Calls, and Topics

Horizon Europe is divided into several Work Programmes, calls, and topics. Each thematic area under Horizon Europe has its own Work Programme. Work Programmes are divided into overarching “destinations”, which are divided into calls, which in turn consist of specific topics. Besides the Cluster Health Work Programme there is the Mission Work programme, that contains the cancer mission topics.
