




As a non-EU country, Switzerland has to negotiate the association to Horizon Europe.

## **Associated Partners**




- Have an active role in the project with tasks and deliverables
- Their role is clearly described in the proposal
- Can lead work packages
- Cannot be coordinators



## **Associated Partners**



- They don't sign the Grant Agreement
- Typically sign the Consortium
   Agreement or a separate collaboration agreement
- Swiss AP costs are eligibile for SERI funding








## The Logic of Horizon Europe & Impact Pathways
