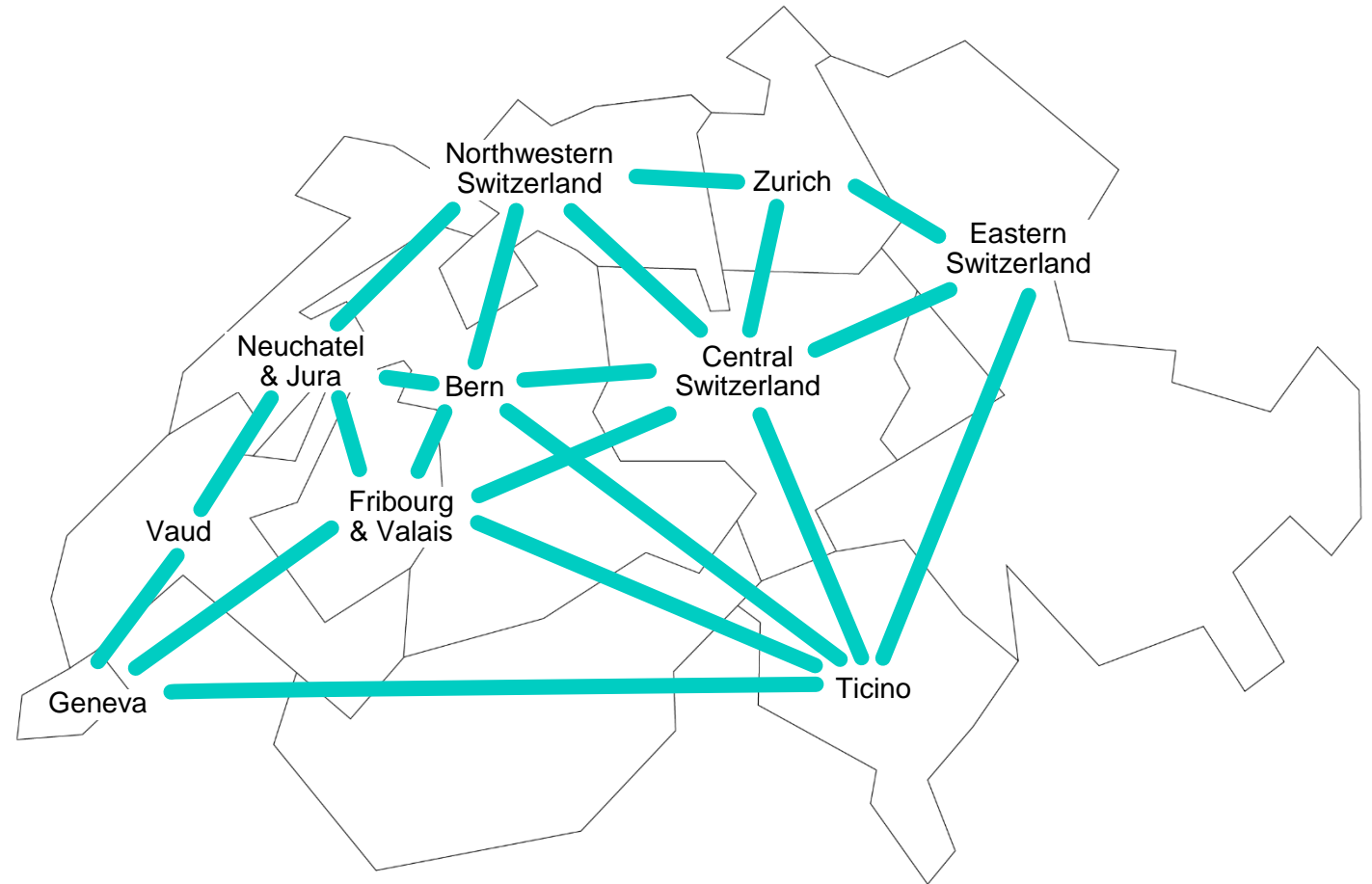

Status of Switzerland in Horizon Europe



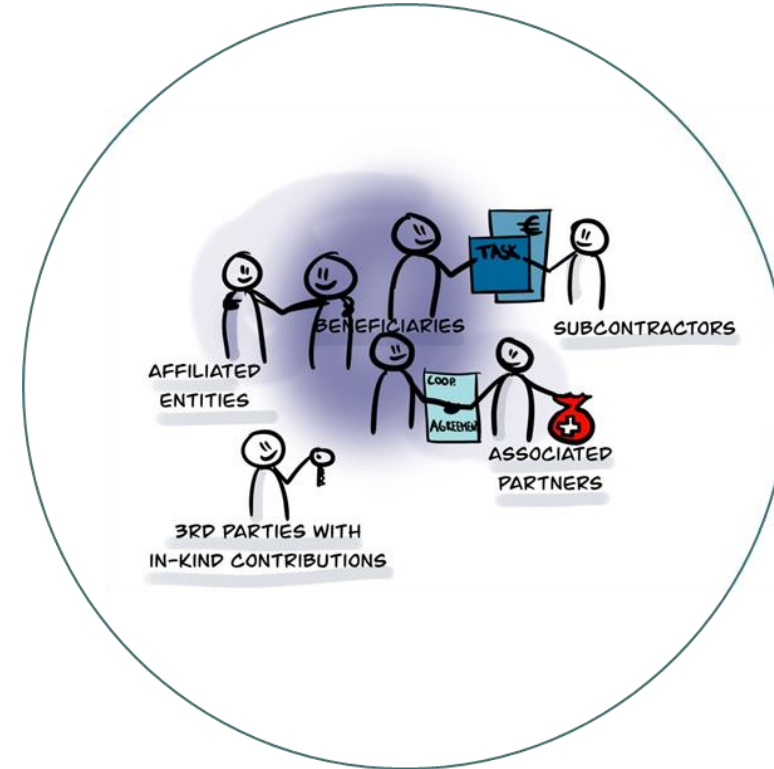
Switzerland is not
(yet) associated to
Horizon Europe.

As a non-EU country, Switzerland has to negotiate the association to Horizon Europe.

Swiss entities can participate in collaborative research projects as “Associated Partners”.

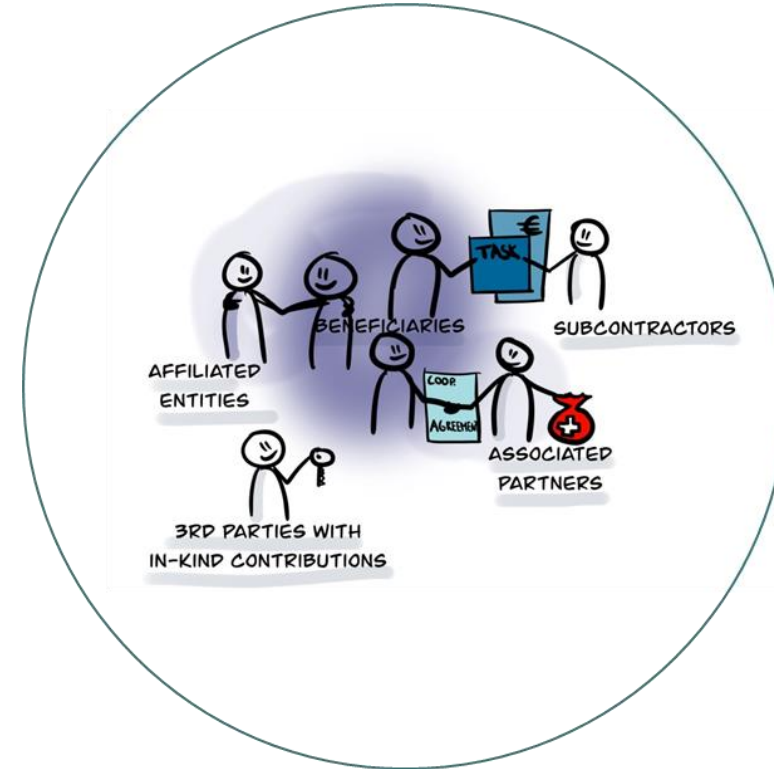
Associated Partners

- Have an active role in the project with tasks and deliverables
- Their role is clearly described in the proposal
- Can lead work packages
- Can^{not} be coordinators



Associated Partners

- They don't sign the Grant Agreement
- Typically sign the Consortium Agreement or a separate collaboration agreement
- Swiss AP costs are eligible for SERI funding

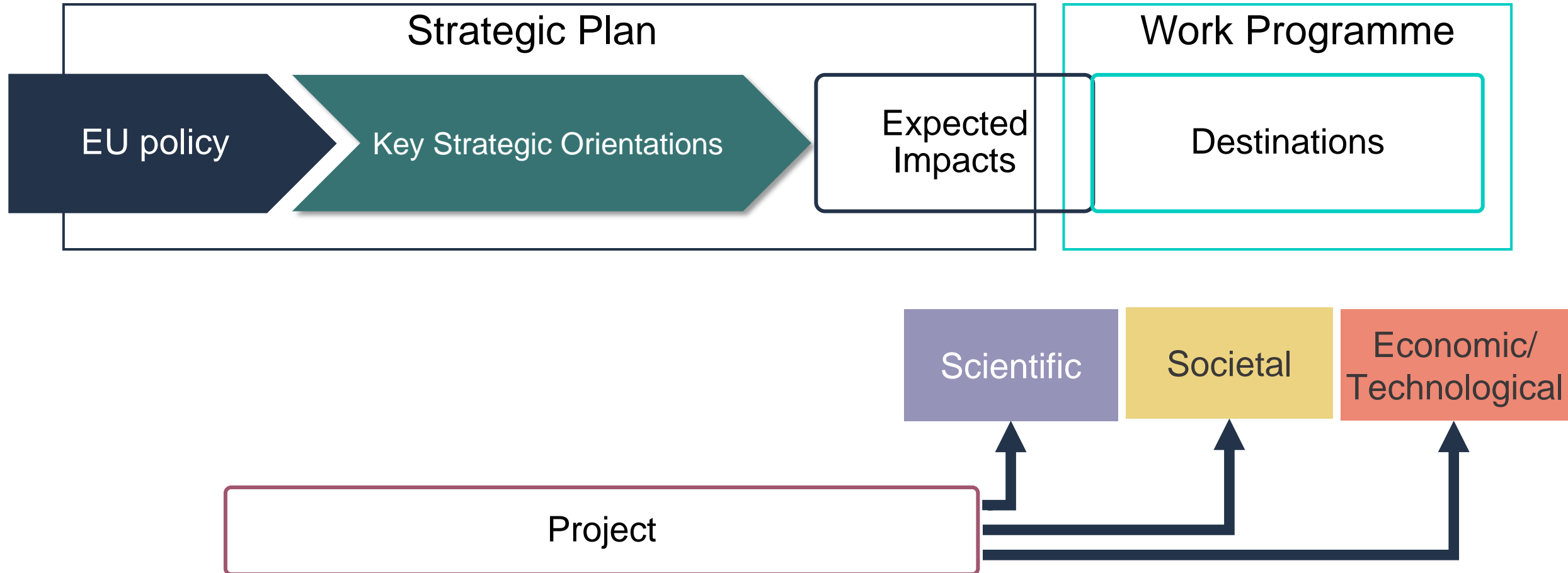

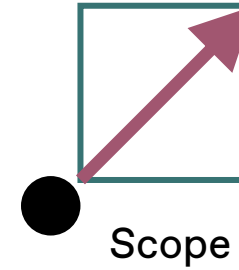
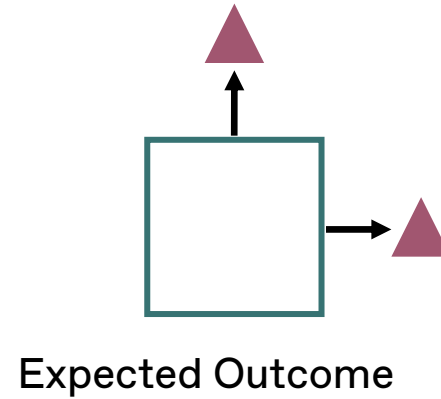
